

Using Your iPhone as a Safety & Security Device when charging at night

Set up “Hey Siri” on your iPhone. (Go to Setting/Siri & Search and turn on all three of the Siri indicators: 1) listen for “hey Siri”, 2) press the side button for Siri, and 3) allow Siri when locked.)

Add Riderwood Security to your Contacts list.

Charge your phone overnight by plugging your charger into an outlet in your bedroom.

If you fall during the night but are not able to get to a pull chord, just say “Hey Siri call Riderwood Security **on Speaker.**”

Security will be called and will be able to hear you because you engaged the speaker phone option. You can then tell them that you have an emergency and our apartment number and any other information that is appropriate. The important thing is that you need to include the “on Speaker” phrase when you call. If you just ask Siri to call Security and you don’t have speaker on they will not be able to hear you.

Get used to using this feature by making your regular phone calls to friends and family by asking Siri to call and put the call on speaker (*Call Pat on mobile on speaker*). You must have the phone number in your contacts list for Siri to make the call. The side benefit is that you can use Siri for lots of things you do manually. The key is using the correct term for him/her as although she is smart, she is not as smart as a 6 year old and you will sometimes get strange results if you use words she doesn’t understand.
